

8th Alliance of Australian Muslims (AAM) National Summit 2025

Etiquettes and Reminders for the Meeting

Purpose and Spirit of the Summit

- 1. Approach the Summit with **a positive and sincere attitude**, remembering that we are here to serve Islam and the Australian Muslim community for the sake of Allah (SWT).
- 2. The AAM Summit aims to **unite the Muslim community** in Australia by focusing on shared priorities and achieving positive, collective outcomes.
- 3. The Summit will **maintain neutrality** towards all mainstream Muslim organisations and groups.
- 4. The discussion will **not mention specific groups or organisations, nor will it** debate Islamic jurisprudence or contested figh matters.
- 5. The Summit is **not a forum to discuss or interfere** in any organisation's internal affairs or structure. It will address only issues of common concern and benefit to the community.
- 6. The Summit will **prioritise the most pressing issues** facing the Muslim community, with the understanding that not every issue can be resolved at once.
- 7. Participants are encouraged to focus on **common ground** and avoid divisive or sensitive topics that may lead to disagreement.
- 8. Discussions should remain **aligned with the official agenda** and its identified areas of focus

Meeting Conduct

- 9. Please keep all comments and contributions **short**, **concise**, **and relevant**. Avoid repeating points that have already been made.
- 10. **Respect others** while they are speaking. Do not interrupt or talk over others.
- 11. Maintain **respect and courtesy** when discussing different opinions. While approaches may differ, our goals and intentions remain united.
- 12. **Confidentiality is essential.** Do not share details, discussions, or names of attendees outside the Summit without explicit permission.
- 13. **No public statements** about the Summit or AAM are to be made unless agreed upon by the majority of attendees.
- 14. Regardless of the outcomes, participants must **support and respect one another** and continue to work together for the common good.
- 15. The Summit must **not be used for personal, organisational, or political agendas**, but solely for the benefit and advancement of the Muslim community.



For Participants Joining via Zoom

- 1. **Test your video and audio** before the meeting begins.
- 2. Ensure you are in a **quiet environment** free from background noise.
- 3. Keep your **camera steady**, minimise unnecessary movement, or turn it off.
- 4. All participants will be **muted by default**. To speak, please use the **Raise Hand** function (found under *Reactions*) and wait for your turn.
- 5. Unmute only when invited to speak.
- 6. Recording of the meeting or discussions is strictly prohibited.
